1. Attention seeking in useless ways

2. Power Seeking:

"You better do what I want"

3. Revenge taking

(because the child feels unloved)

4. Display of inadequacy

- declaring defeat

(helps/contributes)

2. Power Seeking: Shows self-discipline/
independence/resourcefulness

3. Cooperation

4. Withdrawal from conflict
